

Green Bay Packers Titletown Sledding Pavilion

Over 9,000 sq. ft. of extruded concrete "Oko Skin" was installed on the Green Bay Packers Titletown District Sledding Hill. The Green Bay Packers had a vision to create a sports anchored development that not only captures the passion of Packers fans on game day, but also promotes flexible yearround programming.

Architects sought the help of Hughes Group and Centerline Architectural Supply to deliver a high-performance building envelope solution. Custom curved aluminum horizontal sub-framing was fabricated, warehoused, and delivered by Centerline, and installed on the barriers and side profile of the entire 46-foot high hill. "Oko Skin" was then installed over the sub-framing to create a modern and clean effect.

Now completed, Titletown's park features an ice-skating rink and tubing lanes down Ariens Hill in the winter, a fullsize football field, a unique playground and plenty of outdoor games and fitness activities, all in the heart of the action. Future development includes retail, commercial and residential elements.
